

MINOR TRAUMA

Any trauma not meeting the major trauma definition. (Includes minor MVA's or ground level falls).

1. Assessment.
2. Immobilize/control bleeding/bandage/splint if needed.
3. Establish **I.V.** if indicated
4. Analgesics
 - a. **Fentanyl** 25-200 micrograms I.V. titrate for pain control, (25-50 micrograms every 10-15 min. up to 200 micrograms.)
 - i. **Pediatric:** 1 microgram/kg IV (75 micrograms max) or 2 micrograms/kg nasal (100 micrograms max)
 - OR**
 - b. **Morphine** 2-15 mg IV/IM titrate for pain control
 - i. **Pediatric:** 0.1mg/kg IV/IM (4mg max)
 - c. Consider pain scale documentation before and after administration.
 - d. Caution: respiratory depression, hypotension.
5. **Contact Medical Control**
